Fairfield Methodist School (Secondary) students were enthusiastic in their community involvement project. FaithActs provided the opportunity for the students to visit and befriend our participants who reside in Dover. They visited 19 homes on 26 February and invited the residents to their school's carnival.

Raffles Girls' School (Secondary) has worked with FaithActs since 2013 for their annual learning journey. This year, the girls had more interaction with the residents as they cleaned 18 homes of our frail seniors and were involved in providing Health Checks and conducting a craft session. The experiential learning journey were conducted from 5 to 9 March 2018 with 233 Y1 students.

Battles of Life

STRESS



Mdm Sheila (not her real name), 39, has five children aged 5 to 21. Her second marriage ended in a bitter divorce. As the ***sole breadwinner, she battles her daily stress on how the family of 6 are to get by with her \$1,400 income.*** Her eldest stepchild has left the family. Two children are assessed with ADHD and are slow learners.

Three of her children are currently in our after-school programme, The Learning Hub. The children have since improved academically and more well-behaved through our enrichment class, tuition and coaching. Their fees for the after-school programme are waived. Mdm Sheila also receives monthly support such as grocery vouchers and financial assistance. The family still goes through the brunt of divorce and are struggling emotionally to adjust their lives.

CANCER



60 year old Mdm Lee was diagnosed with breast cancer in June 2017. Her first response was to survive the ordeal and stay strong for her daughter. The only breadwinner, Mdm Lee sought support to cover the high medical expenses. FaithActs appealed for help to meet her needs. Though she experienced pains and physical discomfort, Mdm Lee showed strength in character and accepted her conditions. Today, Mdm Lee is back at work with lighter duties and her cancer is now in remission. In her own words, ***"despite of my cancer, I will continue to battle life to see my daughter grow up!"***
