Madam Rina*, 48 years, was struggling to provide for herself and her 2 children.

The few wrong choices she made...

There are days where Madam Rina will just stare into space and spend the entire day sleeping.

The emptiness at home and lack of parental guidance and love affected her children badly. The elder daughter was caught shoplifting and was sent for reformative training. Her younger child was having problems coping in school.

Madam Rina herself was plagued with sickness and was certified unfit to work. It was then that FaithActs stepped in to help her with financial assistance, counselled her and helped the younger child to cope with school work.

Madam Rina hopes to be able to provide the comfort of a home which her children always dream of and is working towards a new home with HDB's redevelopment project.

"With regular home visits and encouragement, Madam Rina slowly recovered well enough to look for a part-time job. She hopes to be able to provide the type of home her children deserve."

To help Madam Rina reintegrate back into the society, she is now working as a caregiver to a 6-month old baby. Although Madam Rina still has a long way towards full recovery, FaithActs continue to counsel her and to look for possible stressors in her life.
