We are grateful to the sponsor, Harold Lim, who has made a difference to our children's learning journey.












Jun – "Different Learning Styles" Workshop






Hari Raya Celebration @Sparkletots Centre on 29 Jun 2018

Battles of life



Mdm C and Children

Mdm C's 7-year old daughter has to leave school as she has incurred arrears of more than \$4K in school fees. Mdm C has another child, 5 year old. Her husband is in remand for 5 years. Unable to work, estranged from her husband's family, she has no relative in Singapore.

Together with a Commissioner of Oaths, we visited the father in prison to obtain his signature to apply for his daughter's citizenship.

We are assisting Mdm C to look for a fulltime job so that she can settle her various daily expenses. We are also helping to raise funds to settle the arrears in school fees.



Mdm Tan, aged 88 years old was referred to FaithActs through her friend who is a client of our centre. We brought her to the clinic to have her infected wound on her sole treated. The constant pain drained her emotionally and physically in addition to the loss of appetite. Mdm Tan has been diagnosed with diabetes for years and worrying that her health will further deteriorate led her to depression.

She lives alone in a small cluttered room infested with pests. She has meals delivered to her on weekdays and she eats leftovers on weekends. Given the various pressing needs, FaithActs worked closely with the Agency of Integrated Care who coordinated with other relevant agencies to help Mdm Tan in a more holistic way. Mdm Tan's wound has healed and is now more positive about life.
